It is very simple to use, and we will assist you when you receive the box.

Recordings are sent out to the listeners each week by Royal Mail and all we ask is that you return the memory stick each week in the postal wallet provided. There is no charge for postage using the wallet provided by Copeland Talking Newspaper.
